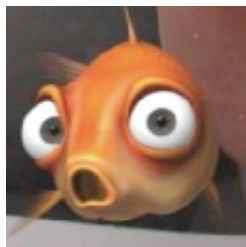

Bravo!FACT-funded short films celebrated at Canadian Film Festivals

(Toronto – August 9, 2007) Several Bravo!FACT (Foundation to Assist Canadian Talent)-funded shorts have been recognized as Canada's prestigious film festivals announced their 2007 programs.

Six shorts have been selected to screen at the **Toronto International Film Festival** in

September 2007, as part of **Short Cuts Canada**. *I Have Seen the Future*, Kris Demeanor's catchy, spoken-word account of a confrontation with suburban Calgary youth, is directed and animated by Cam Christiansen. *Dada Dum* is a surreal, experimental dance narrative set within the aesthetic of an old black-and-white silent film, featuring Caroline Niklas-Gordon and directed by Britt Randle. *The Canadian Shield*, the satirical tale of a Mountie in the Canadian wilderness, stars Josh Peace, Julian Richings and Liane Balaban and is directed by Simon Ennis. *Found Objects*, directed and produced by David Birnbaum, follows the frantic preparations of an elementary school music recital amid the reverberations of a far-off battle. Jesse Rosensweet's *Paradise*, uses stop-motion animation to bring tiny tin characters to life, and *The Cure for Terminal Loneliness*, directed by Samir Rehem, stars Joe Pingue as a man plagued with a serious case of the companionless condition.

Congratulations to the following Bravo!FACT filmmakers who have been accepted to the **TIFF '07 Talent Lab**, a four-day intensive artistic development program: Adam Brodie, Dave Derewlany, Danishka Esterhazy, Karen Hines, Matthew Rankin, and Sean Reycraft. As well, Bravo!FACT recipients Jim Goodall, Paul Lenart, and Soo-Won Lee have been chosen as **Telefilm Canada Pitch This!** finalists. **Pitch This!** is an event that allows Canadian filmmakers the opportunity to present feature film ideas to a large audience of film industry professionals and the Rogers Industry Centre's international voting advisory committee.

The **Montreal World Film Festival** will be screening eight Bravo!FACT-funded films: *Found Objects*, directed by David Birnbaum, *The Interior Monologue of Gill the Goldfish*, directed by Jim Goodall, *Alone in the Dark*, Ari Cohen's profile of Jackie Washington, Mark Montefiore's humorous hockey story, *Back in '93*, Jimmy Larouche's dance-film, *Élise*, choreographed by Marie-Josée Gauthier, Farzin Farzaneh's animated short based on Jon Paul Fiorentino's spoken word piece, *I Wanna Be Your Alpha Male*, Karl Hearne's *Stuff*, and *Homecoming*, Connie Diletti's dark and moving look at post-war trauma.
